

Pursuant to the Statute of Algebra University and the Decision on Establishing a Library, the Senate of Algebra University enacted at its 4th session, held on 26th March 2024, the following

PROGRAMME OF WORK AND DEVELOPMENT OF THE LIBRARY FOR THE PERIOD FROM 2024 TO 2027

Article 1

- (1) The Library of Algebra University (hereinafter: *Library*) was established as a university library and is part of the institution.
- (2) The mission of the Library is to ensure students, teachers, learners, researchers and other employees the use of library material and services, as well as the necessary information sources, with the aim of raising the quality of learning and research at the University and in the community.
- (3) The vision of the Library is to be a modern support centre, where all users can find the necessary information for quality and successful learning, studying and research at the University.

Article 2

- (1) The strategic goals of the Library and the plan for their realisation are shown in the table below.

Goal	Indicator
increasing the number of book material needed for study programmes and education programmes as well as research work	five new titles a year
increasing the number of digitally available content for the purposes of online classes, e-courses and remote access for students and scientists	five new digital titles
increasing the quality of formal and content processing of the library material	corrected errors in signature marks and catalogue records in the computer system for library operations
aligning catalogue records with public standards	all catalogue records in the computer system for library operations aligned with public standards
introduction of a system of insuring book material against theft	all copies secured with RFID tags, RFID antenna installed at the entrance to the Library and protection system put into operation

cooperation with other libraries to promote the importance of information literacy in the community	two collaborations (joint programme, education, collaboration)
participation in European networks of universities	two held workshops, webinars, collaborative activities etc.
raising standards of the virtual environment, new technologies and software	two software improvements, new tools, technologies etc. per year
providing space for closed access to the Library	provided space for 5,000 copies of book material in closed access
conducting revisions and disposal of library material	written-off surplus copies of titles that are no longer mandatory literature for courses

Article 3

- (1) The library staff will continuously work on their professional development, in accordance with the national Standard for Higher Education, University and Scientific Libraries.
