

“Security Day” Contest



Article 1. – Contest organizer

Organizer of the contest “Security Day” is Algebra University College (ID No.: 14575159920), Gradišćanska 24, Zagreb, (hereinafter: the Organizer), sponsored by the NATO and partner company EC-Council. The contest is organized for the purpose of awarding the best contestants in the quiz “Security Day”.

Article 2. – Applying for the contest

Applications for the contest are open from October 24, 2022 to November 15, 2022 on the following link: www.algebra.hr/visoko-uciliste/en/security-day/

Article 3. – Terms of participation in the contest

Three categories of participants are eligible to compete in the contest:

- The first category of the contest is intended exclusively for high school graduates, that is, students completing their final (4th) year of high school in the school year 2022/23.
- The second category of the contest is intended exclusively for final-year undergraduate students, attending their final year of undergraduate studies in the academic year 2022/23, or candidates who have completed their undergraduate program (180 ECTS points).
- The third category of the contest is intended for all IT professionals regardless of the level of their qualifications.

Article 4. Who can participate in the contest

A three-member committee will decide whether a candidate is eligible to participate in the contest, based on the submitted application form available on the following link: www.algebra.hr/visoko-uciliste/en/security-day/

If a candidate satisfies all the conditions, the committee will select 40 participants from each of the categories based on their motivation letter. The candidates who have been selected to participate in the contest will be notified of this by November 18, 2022.

Article 5. – Prize fund

For the purpose of conducting the contest “Security Day”, the organizer has designated a prize fund in the amount of **HRK 101,037.50 / EUR 13,416.31**.

FIRST CATEGORY PRIZE

The award in the first category of the contest is a full 1st-year tuition of the three-year Professional Bachelor Study Program of Applied Computer Engineering – Software or System Engineering programs, conducted in Croatian in the academic year 2023/24 (starting October 2023).

Value of the scholarship is HRK 36,960.00 / EUR 4,908.37.



The award is not transferable and cannot be exchanged for money or used in combination with other discounts and benefits.

The award will be exclusively available to the candidate who wins the competition in the first category, provided that they:

- complete their 4-year high school program in the year 2022/23 (candidates who have completed their high school program outside Croatia must submit a Certificate of the recognition of foreign educational qualifications from the Croatian Ministry of Science and Education),
- successfully pass their Matura state exam (Mathematics, Croatian Language, English Language) in the school year 2022/23.

SECOND CATEGORY PRIZE

The award in the second category of the contest is a full 1st-year tuition of the two-year Professional Master Study Programs of Applied Computer Engineering – Software or System Engineering programs, conducted in English in the academic year 2023/24 (starting in October 2023).

Value of the scholarship is HRK 42,840.00 / EUR 5,689.24.

The award is not transferable and cannot be exchanged for money or used in combination with other discounts and benefits.

The award does not include the possibility of attending and receiving a UK degree from Goldsmiths University of London.

The award will be exclusively available to the candidate who wins the competition in the second category, provided that they:

- have completed their undergraduate study program in computer science or informatics (acquired a minimum of 180 ECTS points). If they have completed a study program in a different field, they must demonstrate an adequate level of prior knowledge in software engineering, systems or network engineering (determined based on the course program of the completed undergraduate study program).
- will complete their undergraduate computer science or informatics study program (acquired a minimum of 180 ECTS points) in the academic year 2022/23. If they complete a study program in a different field, they must demonstrate an adequate level of prior knowledge in software engineering, systems or network engineering (determined based on the course program of the completed undergraduate study program).

THIRD CATEGORY PRIZE

The award in the third category of the contest is the Educational Voucher for the EC-Council Certified Ethical Hacker (CEH) training and certification exam.

Value of the voucher is HRK 2,1237.50 / EUR 2.818,70.

The voucher is not transferable and will be exclusively available to the candidate who wins the competition in the third category.



The voucher cannot be exchanged for money or used in combination with other discounts and benefits.

The voucher is applicable to predetermined dates of the training program, and within a year from receiving the voucher.

Article 6. – Publishing results of the contest

The contest will be held at the address of the Organizer – Algebra University College, Gradišćanska 24, Zagreb, on November 26, 2022. The winner of the contest in each category will be the candidate who scores the highest number of points on the quiz. In the event that two candidates achieve the same number of points, the winner will be the one who achieved that result first, that is, in a shorter period of time.
